





## **Reading at the Library**

#### REQUESTING AN ITEM

If you would like to read a book that we don't have at MCPL, you can request that we buy it.

#### PLACING A HOLD

Sometimes, more than one person wants to check out an item at the same time. To make sure you get a turn, you can put an item on hold.

#### REQUESTING A BOOK BUNDLE

If you would like to read up to 10 books about a single topic, you can request a book bundle and a librarian will find books for you. Those books will then be placed on hold for you.

#### HOW TO REQUEST

- Go to madisonlibrary.org
- Click "Services" at the top of the page
- Click "Request an Item"
- Follow the link and provide the book's information
- We will let you know if we buy the book
- If not, we can place an Inter Library Loan (ILL)

#### HOW TO PLACE

- Go to madisonlibrary.org
- Click "Search" on the search bar (top of page)
- This will take you to our catalog website
- Sign in with your library card (top right)
- Search your item then click on it when it pops up
- Click "Holdings" in top left corner
- Click "Reserve"
- Choose the branch you'd like for pick up
- Click "OK"

#### HOW TO REQUEST

- Go to madisonlibrary.org
- Click the "Just for You" tab at top of page
- Click the "Kids" tab when it pops up
- Scroll down until you see "Material Bundle"
- Fill in all the information about the books you want
- Click "Submit"
- Pick up the books once they have been placed on hold
